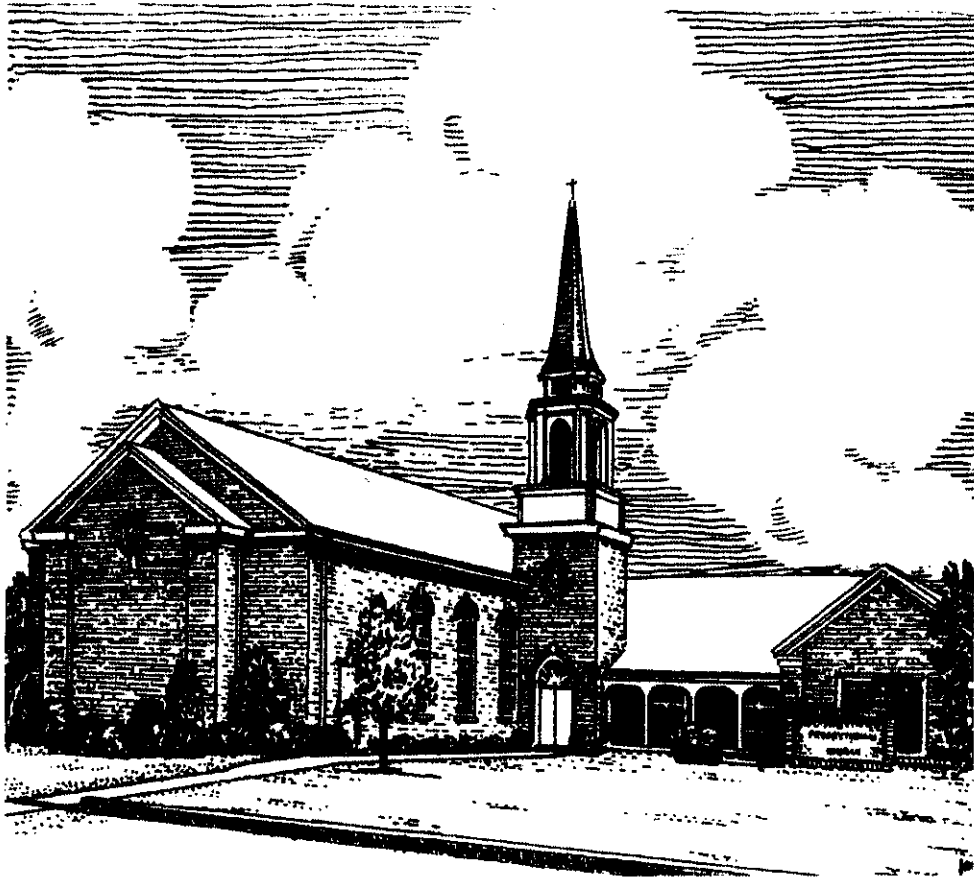

Nicene Creed
